

N.O.R.A. 2011 Dirt Oval Racing Guidelines

Directions to Skagit River Raceways:

I – 5 to Exit #229-George Hopper Road, East on George Hopper Rd. to Burlington Blvd,
North on Burlington Blvd. to Pease Rd, East on Pease Rd. to East Whitmarsh Rd .

Enter at **SKAGIT RIVER RACEWAYS**

General Car/Race Specs-

Class specifications are listed on our WEB Site – www.norarcoval.com You are responsible for the safety of your **Equipment**
ALL CLASSES are transmission classers. 3+gear configuration, **NO DIRECT DRIVE SYSTEMS**
ALL CLASSES may use foam tires or rubber tires with street type tread, or as specified in the **Individual Class Specs. NO PINS.**
ALL 1/10 Scale Electric Classes must use 7.2 volt 6 cell batteries 5000mah NiMh or less or 7.4 volt Lipo's 8000mah or less.
1/18 Scale are allowed to use 1100mah NiMh 6 cell or 1600-20c, 2 cell lipo or less. (Hard Case)
Series #1 is Pro-Stock, must use ROAR approved 13.5 brushless or 19 turn Spec. motor
Series #2 is Modified, any 540 sized brushed or brushless motor.
ALL Nitro vehicles **MUST** have a Throttle Return Spring.
1/10 Scale Nitro vehicles may run either the .12 or .15 RTR motor.
1/8 Scale Nitro vehicles may run either the .21 or the .28 RTR motor.
Aerodynamics – **NO METAL** wings or spoilers. Lexan Side dams are allowed only in 1/10 Nitro Truck, 2wd & 4wd classes.
NO Steering Assist Device on car – (e.g. GYROS)
ALL class races will be 5 minutes, (2 Heats & a Main), with 2 minutes between races.
NO reverse. If used in Heat-Loss of One(1) finishing position in Main.
If used in Main – Zero Points for night.

Corner Marshaling –

You **MUST** corner marshal for the race immediately after your race. Or.
If you are unable to corner, **YOU must find a qualified substitutes (racers or members only)** to take your place.
You should corner marshal in a manner you would like others to corner for you.
You will be docked 10 laps in the main each time you fail to corner, or provide a qualified substitute.

Transponders/Frequency Flags –

All transponders and frequency flags **MUST** be returned immediately after each race – **Before you Corner Marshal.**
Remember - **Do not** turn on your radio unless you have a frequency flag! (Crystal Set users.)
If transponders are taken from the track, the following penalties will be enforced: \$25 late fee, \$125.00 if lost.
It is recommended/encouraged that drivers provide their own personal transponders. Frequency flags will be supplied by the track.

General

Must bring your own table, chair, extension cord and power strip.
Practice sessions are held on Wednesdays, weather permitting.
Work parties for track maintenance will be announced. Please come help. Remember you keep the track going.
Burlington Parks Dept has requested NO Propane BBQs.
All participants in race event understand that entry fees pay for coverage by the license of insurance for each event, computer operator and track maintenance.

Race Fees

Members pay - \$10.00 for 1st class +5.00 for each additional class. Member Rookies \$5.00
Non members/guests pay - \$12.00 for 1st class, +\$6.00 for each additional class. Non Member Rookies-\$6.00./class.
Annual membership fee - \$15.00 Individual + \$10.00 for each additional family member.
